Curriculum Our topic in Term 5 is information, Ready, steady, grow!

In **English**, the children will practise their phonic skills in a daily phonics session.

There will be a big focus on handwriting. They will develop their sentence writing and their awareness of finger spaces, full stops and capital letters.

In **Maths**, we will be learning about multiplication and division. We will be recapping our 2 and 5 times tables as well as learning to count in our 10's. To help us with our multiplication and division, we will making and adding equal groups, arrays and doubles.

Our **Topic**, which will link our learning together, is about plants, animals and humans .We will be looking at different plants, including trees, as well as naming a variety of common animals and being able to place them in different groups including carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

The children will learn about how they grow and change and why babies need support and care as well as understanding that older children can do more by themselves.

We will be thinking about how the school's rules 'Be Ready, Be Kind, Be Safe' apply to us.

Reading .

The children will continue to engage in Reading sessions— both whole class and individually. We will be checking the i reading folders every day, and changing books when 😈 children have read at home with their parents. Those that 😈 un't get a chance to read with their parents will be 🕮 supported to read with adults in the classroom. However, it is important to remind you that regular reading sessions with their grown ups will have a fantastic impact on the progress that your children make. Please read with them as much as you can. Every child in the class will be read with at least once a week by an adult in the class.

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
PE is on a Tuesday.
