Curriculum information

Our topic in Term 6 is

'We are authors!'



In **English**, the children will practise their phonic skills in a daily phonics session. We will be looking at famous authors including Anthony Browne and Eric Carle.

There will be a big focus on handwriting. They will develop their sentence writing and their awareness of sentence structures and multiple punctuation.

In **Maths**, there will be a focus on many different measurements including money and time. They will develop their knowledge with coins and notes and learning how to spend the correct value. Regarding time, they will learn to say the time to the hour and half hour.

Our **Topic**, which will link our learning together, is all about authors. We will be looking at different authors including Anthony Browne and Eric Carle and creating fact files about them and studying some different books they have written

The children will learn about how to use their own initiative and to be able to show initiative, we must be able to make decisions.

We will be thinking about how the school's rules 'Be Ready, Be Kind, Be Safe' apply to us.

Reading

The children will continue to engage in Reading sessions— both whole class and individually. We will be checking the i reading folders every day, and changing books when 😈 children have read at home with their parents.
