

Curriculum information

Our topic in Term 2 is

`Lets celebrate!'



In Maths, we will be thinking about numbers up to 20, adding and subtracting them as well. We will also be looking at 2D and 3D shapes.

Our **Topic**, which will link our learning together, is about celebrations. We will be looking at different celebrations that are celebrated around the world including Diwali, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

We are also focusing on our Nativity W/B 23rd November. More information will follow regarding this but our aim is to film the nativity and combine it into one big film throughout Key Stage 1.

The children will learn about belonging to different groups such as family, school, etc. We will learn how we need rules to keep us safe and happy and how we look after each other. We will be thinking about how the school's new rules 'Be Ready, Be Kind, Be Safe' apply to us.

The children will continue to engage in Reading sessions— both whole class and individually.
