



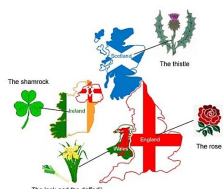

Curriculum information

Our topic in Term 1 is 'Castles'



This term our topic is Castles. We will be learning about the four countries that make up the United Kingdom in this Geography based topic.

We have linked Literacy, Art, Geography and Topic together to look at the subject from a variety of angles. We will be using maps, looking at flags and castles, capital cities and culture.

In **Maths** this term, we will be working on number and place value, addition and subtraction, continuing with Big Maths and times tables each week and will be using our skills to solve problems.

In English, we will be using stories about princes, princesses and dragons to learn how to use adjectives and adverbs to describe a character. We will also have a quick recap of writing instructions. In phonics, we will recap the Phase 5 sounds from the Letters and Sound programme, before moving on to the No Nonsense Spelling programme.

In Computing, we will use the Scratch programme and in Science we are learning about animals, including humans. In PHSE, we will follow the Zippy's Time programme, beginning with the Friendships programme.

On Thursday 6th September we will begin our topic with a visit from KIC Theatre who will lead us in drama workshops, covering all aspects of life in castles.

P.E is on Thursday and Friday.

Please could you ensure your child has their P.E kit in school. **Please remove earrings on these days** - this is an important health and safety issue. **Children may wear jogging bottoms and a sweatshirt for outdoor PE lessons.**



How can you help at home?

- Times tables songs
- Reading - books, comics, signs, labels
- Spelling tricky words e.g. There and their, here and hear etc.
- Writing simple stories/news using adjectives
- Adding two or three small numbers
