Curriculum information

Our topic in term 5 is 'Our favourite stories'



This term our topic is 'Our favourite stories'. Each week we will choose a different story to focus on, starting with Jack and the Beanstalk. The children will be planting beans and lots of other seeds for our garden. We look forward to seeing the changes over time and finding out what plants need to grow.

In Maths this term, we will be recapping addition and subtraction, whilst using a variety of representations, beginning to introduce the concept of sharing objects (division) and introducing money. We will be learning to recognise different coins and choosing the correct ones to pay with.

In **Literacy**, we will be reading lots of different stories and traditional tales. We will be predicting how stories might end, using puppets to retell stories, writing instructions and labelling maps.

In **Phonics**, the children will be continuing to either recap phase 2 or 3. We will be writing simple sentences but focussing on correctly using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. Additionally, we will be recognising and writing tricky words, correctly and independently, within sentences.

We will be inviting parents/carers in on Friday 17th May, which will be for an hour, with a focus on writing.


Home learning

How can you help at home?

Please support your child to continue to practise writing their name in cursive.

- -Practising recognising and writing letter sounds and tricky words e.g. the, and, I, no, go, to, the, into, me, he, be, she, they, her, are, was, you, all, my.
- -Blending sounds already learnt to make words e.g. c-a-t, p-e-g
- -Practising counting and recognising numbers to 20.
- -Using a variety of representations of addition and subtraction e.g. part part whole, bar model etc.
- -Using scissors.
- -Getting dressed and undressed.
- -Recognising 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.
- -Exploring changes in the environment e.g. how do plants grow and what they need.
