Our **Topic**, which will link our learning together, is about celebrations. We will start with learning about Harvest Festival and Bonfire Night. We will then explore the Christian cele bration of Christmas.

In **Science**, we will be learning about involved in the celebrations. They will learn about different everyday materials and explore their properties. The children will have lots of hands on learning and develop their investigative skills.
