Curriculum information

Our topic in Term 2 is 'Dinosaurs'



English: Our English learning will focus on dinosaurs and we will be studying the story 'Dinosaur Trouble' by Dick King Smith and 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth' for our instructional text.

Maths: Our topics this term will be addition and subtraction and multiplication and division.

Science: In Science we will be learning about Animals including Humans.

PE: This term we will be learning about Dance and Netball.
