Curriculum information

Our topic in Term 2 is
The Great Fire of London.



This term, we will be learning all about *The Great Fire of London*. During our topic lessons, we will be comparing present day London to the London that existed before 1666, learning about life in the 17th Century and discovering the events of the Great Fire. We will also be learning about how London was rebuilt after the fire and will be designing our own city.

In our English lessons we will be using the text *Toby and The Great Fire of London* to support our learning. We will be focussing on descriptive writing, creating our own settings, discussing character's actions and retelling a story from the perspective of another character.

In **Maths** we will continue to learn new skills in solving addition, subtraction and multiplication calculations as well as learning about money. We will be applying these skills to solve problems and in reasoning about our methods.

Our **Computing** focus is all about photography and in learning to take and edit our photos.

In **P.E** we will be taking part in dance sessions as well as learning how to use our attacking, defending and shooting skills in a range of sports.

In **Science** we will be learning about **Animals including Humans** and we will focus on exercise and keeping healthy.

This term also sees us begin our rehearsals for our **Nativity** performances. There will be further details to follow about costumes, timings and lines!
