Our topic in Term 2 is

`Celebrations'



Our Topic, which will link our

learning together, is about celebrations. We will start with learning about Harvest Festival and Bonfire Night. We will then explore the Christian celebration of Christmas.

In Computing, we will be using digital technology to create, organise, store, and manipulate digital content, to produce a Christmas Card.

In **English**, we are learning to be story tellers. The children will learn to tell a story 'The Little Red Hen' from memory and explore it further in their writing sessions. They will continue to practise their phonic skills in a daily phonics session. They will develop their sentence writing, finger spaces and their awareness of full stops, capital letters and question marks. There will continue to be a big focus on handwriting patterns and the cursive script.

In Maths, the children will continue to have a daily Big Maths session where they build on their counting skills, by counting to 100 in ones and counting in 2s,5s,and 10s. They will also learn addition facts to 10. In their maths lessons, they will explore addition, subtraction and shape.

In Science, we will be learning about materials. They will learn about different everyday materials and explore their properties. The children will have lots of hands on learning and develop their investigative skills.
