Our topic in term 2 is 'Dinosaurs'





English: Our English learning will focus on dinosaurs and we will be studying the story of the Christmasaurus and the classic Rags to Riches story structure.

Maths: Our topics for this term are 2d and 3d shapes. We shall then be studying multiplication and division, including problem solving in lots of practical ways and finally look at length and mass.

Science: This term, we are looking at rocks and fossils. We shall compare rocks, and find out about different rock types. We shall look at fossil formation and learn about soil structure.

Topic: We will be learning all about Dinosaurs! What were they, when were they around and where were they. Our art and DT will also be dinosaur themed.

PE: Dance will be on a Tuesday and Netball will be on a Wednesday.

PSHE: We will be learning about communication and in RE we are looking at festivals.

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Reading books
