Curriculum information

Our topic in term 5 is 'Nocturnal Animals'



This term our topic is 'Nocturnal Animals'. We have linked Science, English, Music, Art, Computing and topic together to look at the subject from a variety of angles. We will be making masks, salt dough sculptures, composing and performing music and drama as well as investigating habitats and adaptations. The children will learn about data bases in the We Are Zoologists computing unit.

In **Maths** this term, we will be revising multiplication and division, learning to tell the time to the quarter hour and five minute intervals, working with mass and comparing different units of measurement.

In English, we will be reading The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark and completing a unit of work on a tale of fear. This will include drama and speaking and listening as well as reading and narrative writing. After this we will look at writing explanations for our non-fiction element.

In **Spelling** we will be learning to make plurals and to add a variety of prefixes and suffixes.

In SRE we will be looking at growth and differences between boys and girls.

In **PE** the children will be learning cricket skills.

In **RE** we will complete our look at special Jewish symbols such as the Menorah.
