

Look at the activities below. Choose at least 3 that you would like to support your child with. Once completed, bring them to school on the dates given. You must include at least 1 piece of writing (red boxes), plus complete the two yellow boxes. Hand in dates are 21/9/2018, 5/10/2018 and 19/10/2018.

Our topic this term is Scotland.	Write a travelogue about a holiday you have been on. Tell us what you did, where you went and how it made you feel. Would you recommend the holiday? Why?	Make a 3D model of a famous landmark from Scotland	Research the clothing of Scotland and compare this to what we wear in this country. Why is the clothing different?
Research poetry from Scotland and try to write a poem in this style.	Create a poster that would encourage people to go on holiday to Scotland? (think about famous Scottish landmarks)	Research an art style from a Scottish artist. Now create your own picture in this style.	How would you travel to Scotland? Plan your route and describe your journey.
Using the alphabet, find out as much as you can about Scotland: eg: A-Aberdeen H - Haggis T - Tossing the Caber Remember to include all the letters of the alphabet.	What are the national Sports of Scotland? Are they in the Olympics? If not do you think they should be? Why? Who plays them? Are they a mixed team? Think about how you could present this.	Work on all your times tables, especially the 6 and 8 times tables and the relationship between them. By the end of year 4 you are expected to know ALL your times tables from 1x1 to 12x12, so you need to practise!	We expect children to continue to achieve excellent improvements in their AR scores.
