We are continually assessing the children's progress and those making the most progress are supported at home by:

- Reading at least 3 times a week.
- Being read to regularly using books with rich descriptive vocabulary and from a variety of genres. [Stories, poems, information books, longer stories with chapters.]
- Answering comprehension questions.
- Practising number facts to 10, 20, 30 or 100 as appropriate.
- Telling the time and using money in real life situations.
- Spelling the common exception words regularly.
