- design a piece of Roman jewellery and make it
- investigate to see if there are any Roman roads built near us
- create a menu for a Roman banquet
- create a fact file on a famous Roman Emperor
- write about the 4 main features of Roman baths. Where can they be found in England?
- create a poster showing the clothing worn by a Roman person

The projects will be due in on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October 2019.

We are continually assessing the children's progress and those making the most progress are supported at home by:

- Reading at home every evening
- Being read to regularly using books with rich descriptive vocabulary and from a variety of genres. [Stories, poems, information books, longer stories with chapters.]
- Answering comprehension questions.
- Working on all of your times tables, especially the 6 and 9 times tables and the relationship between them.
- Telling the time and using money in real life situations.
- Practising the year 3 and 4 spellings.
