<p>Research poetry from one of the following countries and try to write a poem in this style.</p>	<p>Create a poster that would encourage people to go on holiday to one of the cotinents listed.</p>	<p>Research food from a country and find a recipe, make it if you can.</p>	<p>Plan your journey to a country from one of the continents- would you travel by train, plane, car or ship</p>

Present them in a fact sheet, poster, powerpoint.</p>	<p>Make a postcard imagining you are at a destination in one of the continents.</p>	<p>Work on all your times tables, especially the 6 and 9 times tables and the relationship between them. Look at the division facts for them.
