- Toga** - a loose flowing outer garment (clothing)
- Boudicca** - a Celtic Queen who fought the Romans
- Empire** - a group of settlements or countries ruled by a single person
- Emperor** - the ruler of an empire
- Hadrian's Wall**- the north-west frontier of the Roman empire for nearly 300 years

55 BC Julius Ceaser fails to conquer England.	43 AD Rome successfully invades England.	61 AD Boudicca leads the Celtic revolt and war.	80 AD The colosseum was built in Rome.	121 AD Hadrian's wall is built between England and Scotland.	285 AD The Roman Empire is divided between Emperors.	410 AD The end of the Roman rule over England.
