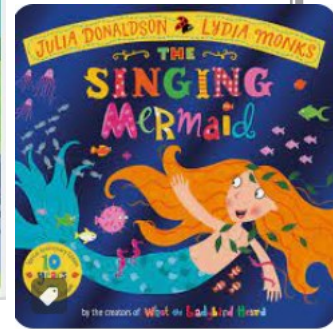
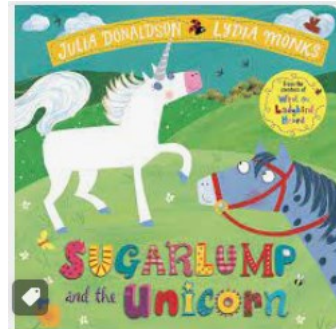
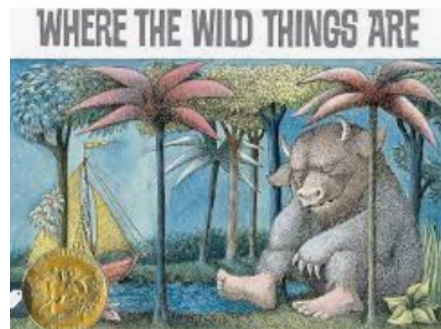
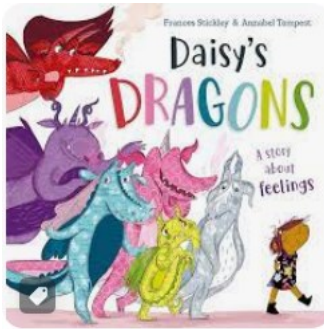


# Reception Knowledge Organiser
