I didn't reply but then suddenly I did,

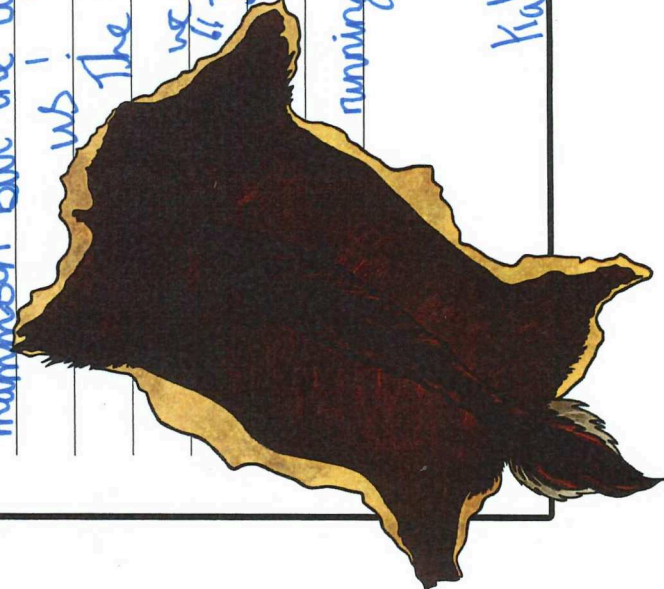
"Time to panic we are in a snow storm and I can hardly see some saber-tooth tigers closing in so run!" I announced.
