



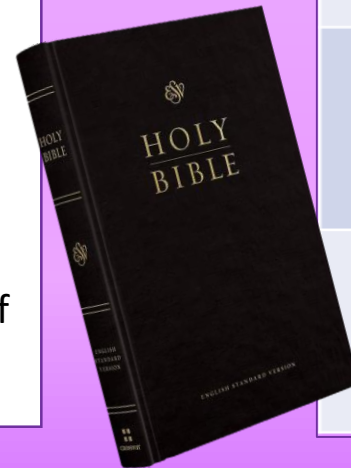


What I should already know:
