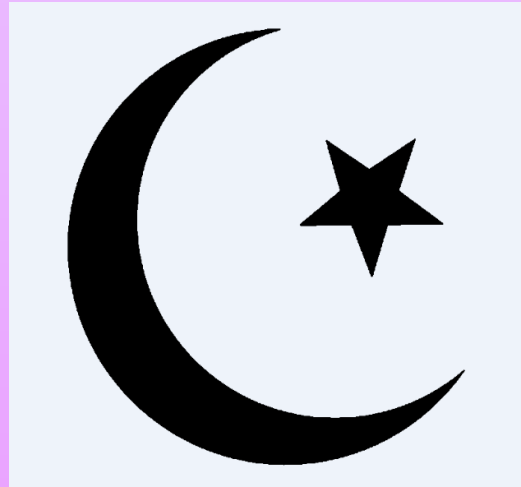
## Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?

 mosque	A Muslim place of worship.
 Quran	The Islamic sacred book, believed to be the word of God.
