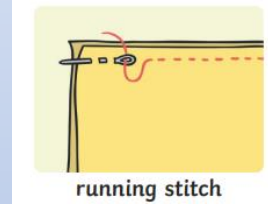
# Design and Technology



This term we will be using our knowledge on textile joining techniques to make an Ancient Egyptian Collar Necklace.

## What I should already know:

- Materials can be cut, shaped and joined to make products.
- Textiles are materials like fabric and felt.
- Some materials are stronger than others.
- Designs are planned before making a product.
- Patterns can repeat shapes and colours.

## What I will learn:

- Ancient Egyptians wore jewellery to show wealth, status and protection.
- Egyptian jewellery often used symbols such as the Eye of Horus, scarabs and lotus flowers.
- How to design a collar necklace inspired by Ancient Egyptian styles.
- How to join textiles using sewing.
- How to strengthen jewellery using knots and careful stitching.
- How to evaluate a finished product and suggest improvements.

## Key Vocabulary

Word	Definition
jewellery	Decorative objects worn on the body such as necklaces or bracelets.
textiles	Materials made from fabric or cloth.
pattern	A repeated shape or decoration.
symbol	A picture or sign that represents an idea.
Running stitch	A simple sewing stitch that goes in and out of the fabric.
Join	to connect two materials together
strengthen	To make something stronger so it does not break.
