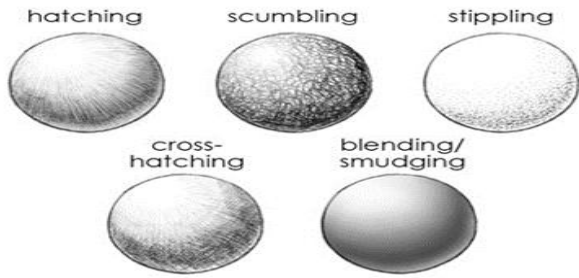


Viking artwork – Patterns, shading and portraits

Types of shading



blending	Shading by changing the pressure applied to the medium and then blending the tones to create a smooth transition
stippling	Shading objects by drawing many small dots to create lighter and darker tones
scumpling	Shading objects by scribbling to create lighter and darker tones
illuminated manuscript	A manuscript in which the text is supplemented with decoration as initials, borders and miniature illustrations
positive space	The object in the artwork
negative space	The space around an object in the artwork
