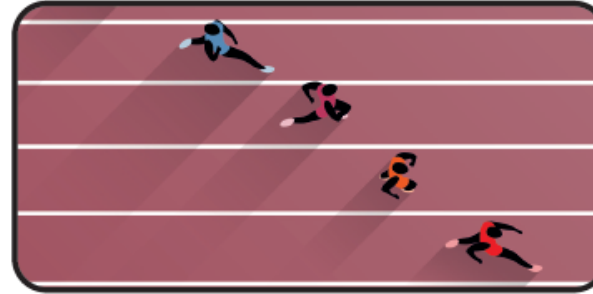

Pitch

Motif = a short melody used as a basis for a longer piece of music.



Harmony = Two or more notes that sound at the same time.



Texture = layers of sound.

Composers add layers of sound or parts to create their music.

Melody & Accompaniment

Melody = singer.

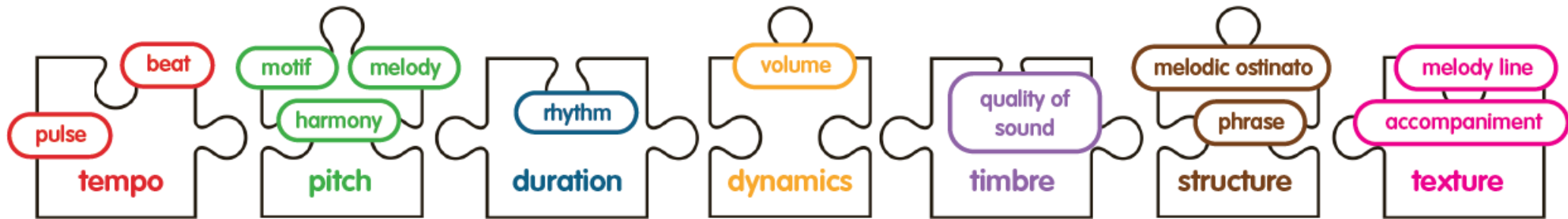
Melody = solo performances.

Accompaniment = drums, bass, guitar, keyboard.

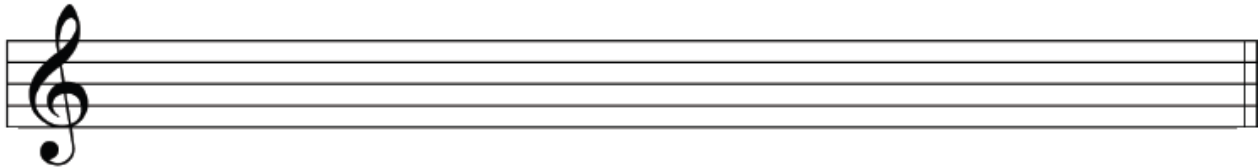
Accompaniment = orchestra.

Rhythm reminder

-  = 4 beats (wade) = semibreve
-  = 2 beats (stride) = minim
-  = 1 beat (walk) = crotchet
-  = 1/2 + 1/2 beat (jogging) = quaver
-  = 1/4 + 1/4 + 1/4 + 1/4 beat (running faster) = semiquaver

Structure

- Ostinato = a repeating pattern.



- Melodic ostinato = a repeating note pattern.



- Rhythmic ostinato = a repeating rhythm pattern.
