Key Facts

- Plants turn sunlight into food so that they can grow.
- Plants use their roots to get water
- Deciduous trees lose their leaves in winter, whereas evergreen trees keep their leaves all year



Key Vocabulary



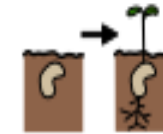
Deciduous

A tree that loses its leaves in the Autumn.



Evergreen

A tree that does not lose its leaves.



Germination

The stage of the plant cycle where the seed begins to grow roots.



Plants

Plants are living things that grow from the soil and turn light from the Sun into food.



Root

Part of the plant that is usually hidden underground and gives the plant water and food from the soil.
