Dear Parents / Carers,

SEX AND RELATIONSHIPS EDUCATIONS (SRE)

We thought it would be useful to inform you of the particular areas that we will be focusing on in Sex and Relationships Education (SRE) in Terms 5 & 6. This may help you prepare for the possible questions or topics that your child might wish to discuss. SRE is a compulsory part of our Personal, Social, Health Education Curriculum taught throughout the school.

In Reception, children will be taught:

- * To consider the routines and patterns of a typical day
- * To understand some areas in which they can look after themselves e.g. dressing and undressing
- * To understand why hygiene is important
- * To understand some basic hygiene routines
- * To recognise that all families are different
- * To identify different members of the family
- * To understand how members of a family can help each other

Parents can withdraw their child from the parts of Sex and Relationship Education (SRE) which fall outside the National Curriculum. Any parent/carer wishing to withdraw their child should discuss this with the class teacher in the first instance and then in writing to the Headteacher by Wednesday 9 May 2018.

An appointment between the Headteacher and parent/carer will be made to discuss the withdrawal. If after this meeting the parent still wishes the child to be withdrawn, the child will be provided with related work and sent to an alternative class when SRE is being taught.
