To give Year 6 the send-off they deserve and to celebrate the end of their SATs, we have planned two exciting activities to mark this occasion.

The first event is a trip to *Chessington World of Adventures*. This has been provisionally booked for Monday 21st May. Children will need to be in school at 8am as the coach will leave promptly at 8.30am. We will be returning to school around 5pm, children should be collected from school at this time. On our way back, we will be in contact with the school so they can text you in case traffic is slow.



The children will need a packed lunch and a boxed type drink in a rucksack as they will need to carry it all day - no glass bottles, cans, fizzy drinks or chocolate bars please. We also suggest providing a snack and drink for mid-afternoon.

The children are required to wear school uniform but can wear comfortable shoes such as trainers. If rain is forecast, please ensure that your child brings a waterproof jacket. The children will not need any money.



The second is a Party which will be held on Wednesday 11th July, starting straight after school until 6.30pm. Children may bring in home clothes to change into and more details will be sent out a little nearer the time

We are asking for a parental contribution of £20 per child toward the cost of both activities, with the school subsidising the remainder. However, if we do not receive sufficient parental contributions, unfortunately, it will not be possible to go ahead with the Chessington trip.
