



Dear Parents / Carers,

On the 4th June 2018 we will be launching our very own 'Snack Shack', situated on the school playground. We will be offering the children, in Years three to six, an opportunity to purchase a healthy snack to be eaten during morning break. We aim to encourage Healthy Eating at South Avenue Primary School, therefore the snacks on sale will be fruit and vegetables, continuing from the free fruit and vegetables provided in Key Stage One.

The 'Snack Shack' will be run by some of our Year Five and School Council pupils. It will be open every day during morning break. At first we will be offering the opportunity to purchase either apples, pears, bananas, carrots or a mixed fruit snack box. As time goes by, we hope to extend the range of healthy snacks on offer.

Each healthy snack will cost 20p. The children can either bring in 20p on the day, or if you prefer, they can buy enough snacks for the week. By handing in a **£1** in a named envelope, your child will be given a passport with five spaces in which to collect stamps each time a snack is chosen. If all five snacks are not chosen during a particular week, the passport may be used in the future until completed. Children will be responsible for their own money or passports.
