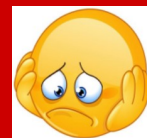
Weekly Attendance Figures

Book Donations!

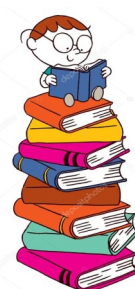
