Your child will be expected to wear their full school uniform. Wellington boots should be worn but school shoes will be needed too; in a named carrier bag please.

All children will need a packed lunch, including a drink (not fizzy) that day. Children will be responsible for carrying their own lunch around the Park, so please send in a ruck sack and no vacuum flasks or glass bottles. Children eligible for free school meals are entitled to have a packed lunch provided by the kitchen. Please indicate on the slip below if you require the kitchen to provide a packed lunch for this trip. **This must be ordered by Friday 9<sup>th</sup> March.**

A voluntary contribution of £12.00 is requested for the visit toward the cost the coach and entrance to the Park. The school will be subsidising this trip. All monies should be given to the class teacher in a sealed envelope bearing the child's name, class and the amount of money sent in. **We ask that this is paid in full no later than Friday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2018.** We must stress, however, that if total contributions do not cover the costs, then the visit will have to be cancelled.
