Create a colour wheel to demonstrate understanding of colours.

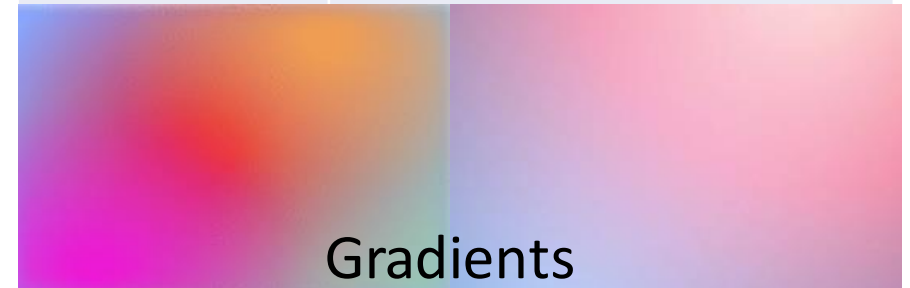
## What I will learn:

How to closely study the different aspects of the river and choose how to represent this in the painting.

We will learn how to use a range of watercolour techniques including blending colours, creating a graded wash, lifting off paint and making a gradient.

## Key Vocabulary

Word	Definition
blending	Mixing two colours to make a new colour
Gradient	Mixing two colours gradually, without a clear start and end of the colours
Graded wash	Starting with a dark colour and adding water until it becomes a lighter shade.
Lifting off paint	Removing part of the paint.



Gradients
