What should I already know and be able to do?

- Christians show their beliefs about Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday in worship.

- The resurrection of Jesus is important to a Christian and they remember and celebrate Jesus in the 'Holy Week'.

- Christians see Holy Week as the final week of Jesus' earthly life, leading to his death.
- There were various events in Holy week such as the Last Supper and that they were important in showing the disciples what Jesus came to earth to do.

What will I know and be able to do by the end of this topic?

- Christians read the 'big story' of the Bible as pointing out the need for God to save the people. This salvation includes the going restoration of humans' relationship with God.
- The New Testament says that Jesus' death was somehow 'for us'.
- Christians interpret this in a variety of ways: for example, as a sacrifice for sin; as a victory over sin, death and the devil; paying the punishment as a substitute for everyone's sins; rescuing the lost and leading them to God; leading from darkness to light, from slavery to freedom.
- Christians believe that Jesus calls them to sacrifice their own needs to the needs of others and some are prepared to die for others and from their faith.
